The 2010 growing season was steady and relatively mild, until rains at harvest threatened, and brought harvest to a swift and abrupt end for most. Because we are a big mountain Cabernet winery, we are always the last off the hill. We prefer the longest hang times possible that will benefit the final product, and we think the waiting really paid off for this remarkable vintage.

Winemaker Thomas Rivers Brown says that it takes him three years to dial-in a vineyard, and our 2010 vintage is year three with Thomas Brown. The wine is a powerhouse of intense focus – a combination of pristine mountain fruit and masterful cellar skills.

Our 2010 Little Sister Proprietary Red Wine is a blend of estate Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot. Luscious dark berry fruit, purple flowers and Diamond Mountain minerality are seamlessly woven into this delicious red.
